Youth and the Body of Christ: Keeping our young people involved in the Catholic Church.

Join Dr. Mark Krejci, Director of the Office of Marriage, Family & Life in the Diocese of Crookston, on Wednesday, May 17, at 6:30pm for a “Praysentation” on how we can keep our youth engaged in the Catholic Church as they become young adults. Dr. Krejci will describe the results of a survey of all 9th and 11th grade students in the Diocese, and you will learn about the key role all adults in the parish play in helping our youth grow into engaged young Catholics. There will not only be time for listening but also time for praying for our youth, their parents, for all adults who witness their Catholic faith to young people and for young adults who have left the Church. Finally, Dr. Krejci will review, based on survey results, some concrete steps parish communities can take to best prepare youth for life-long engagement with their Catholic Faith.
